GOP primary winner appointed to board seat

DUPAGE COUNTY -- J.R. "Jerry" McBride, winner of the Republican primary election for the DuPage County Board's 4th District, was appointed to the board Tuesday to replace John Noel, who died of cancer in April.

McBride, an insurance broker from Glen Ellyn, will serve the remaining six months of Noel's term representing District 4, which covers all or parts of Wheaton, Winfield, Glen Ellyn, Carol Stream and Glendale Heights. If McBride wins the general election as expected, he will then take his own seat on the board representing District 4.

McBride was appointed to fill Noel's vacancy by County Board Chairman Robert Schillerstrom at a special meeting Tuesday, at which other board members unanimously approved the appointment.
